

## Advance Cash Loans for \$1000 Above Income

Most advance cash loans banks look in to that you have at least \$1000 or above income. The other requirements that they normally look in to you is: &bull; You be employed in a regular job. &bull; You have a savings or checking account that is currently active. &bull; You should be 18 years or above in age.

Most advance cash loans are processed online and are verified and transacted pretty quickly than you would normally expect. The online application process for advance cash loans is very secure, easy to get done, time saving and very fast. Most advance cash loans lenders claim that the process of verification is over within an hour and if you qualify the money will be transferred to your account in just an hour from the time you fill in an online application form. It may take as late as 24 hours and most advance cash loans should be returned within 14 to 18 days depending upon what your lender requires. How much amount can advance cash loans offer ? Advance cash loans are offered from \$100 to \$500 or up to \$1000 depending on how much you need and how much you qualify for. Bad credit ranking can still get you advance cash loans. But if you have applied to get bankruptcy or if you have had multiple bankruptcies most lenders may not risk lending you with money. Extra charges are levied if you are approved with advance cash loans. Most lenders do not charge you for applying for loans online. However after processing and verifying your credibility if they are ready to give you a loan they may apply a small amount for processing fee, which will be reduced from the loan amount that is to be sanctioned before it is transferred to your account. They will seek your agreement for this charge. If you do not agree they may not give you the loan. If you are sanctioned with \$500 as advance cash loan and the processing fee is 15% the lender will reduce the amount from your lending sum and he will deposit \$425 to your account but your pending due will still be \$500 and not \$425. If you do not repay on time you may have roll over charges and penalties! However if you pay on time you can always use them for emergency crisis management. Well, it is pretty evident that payday loans are dangerous when you see the initial deduction!
